

Flood Evidence Gathering Drop-in Session

Nottinghamshire County Council (NCC) has organised a drop in session as a follow up to the June Parish Council meeting at the

Methodist Community Centre

on

Monday 9th July between 2pm and 7pm

The session is designed to collect information about the flooding event on 2nd June and help ensure the understanding of what happened on the night of the flooding is as accurate as possible by listening to and talking with those that experienced the flooding first hand.

Both NCC as Lead Local Flood Authority and the Internal Drainage Board (IDB) will be in attendance.

Examples of the sort of information that would be useful are:

- Information about when the rain started and stopped.
- When people started to see a noticeable rise in the water level; and when did it noticeably recede.
- What was the flow direction of the water; where did it come from and go to?
- Any videos or CCTV of the water flows and photos of the flooding.
- Any personal rain gauges that people managed to get a rainfall amount from.

Anybody who suffered from or witnessed the flooding is encouraged to drop in and share their knowledge with the staff.

The session is designed to be as informal as possible and the staff attending will collate all the information shared which will be used to help determine what can be done to reduce the risk of flooding in the village.
